Terms and Conditions

1. Trial Period: The Borrower is permitted to borrow the instrument and/or bow from Coghill String Instruments for a duration of 7 calendar days, including the day of pick-up. The instrument and/or bow must be returned to the Shop by the end of the 7th day.
2. Condition of Return: The Borrower agrees to return the instrument and/or bow in the same condition it was in when it was first borrowed.
3. Responsibility: The Borrower acknowledges that they are solely responsible for the instrument and/or bow during the trial period. In the event of loss, theft, or destruction of the instrument and/or bow, the Borrower shall be liable to pay Coghill String Instruments the full market price.
4. Damage Liability: In the event of damage to the instrument and/or bow during the trial period, the Borrower shall be responsible for covering the cost of repairs and any loss of value incurred by the instrument.
5. Shop's Responsibility: Coghill String Instruments shall not be held responsible for any damage, loss, or theft of the instrument and/or bow during the trial period.
6. Purpose of Trial Period: The primary objective of the trial period is to allow the Borrower time to assess whether they wish to proceed with the purchase of the instrument and/or bow.

7. Purchase or Return: On or before the 7th day of the trial period, the Borrower may choose to either purchase the instrument and/or bow or return it to Coghill String Instruments.

8. Termination of Agreement: This Agreement shall automatically terminate upon the return of the instrument and/or bow to Coghill String Instruments at the end of the 7-day trial period provided that it is returned in good condition.

9. Instrument case: any receptacle or instrument case being borrowed must also be returned undamaged at the end of the trial period.

10. Entire Agreement: This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between Coghill String Instruments and the Borrower regarding the borrowing of the instrument and/or bow and supersedes all prior agreements, whether written or oral.
